

Adventure Pass allows WDM Library card holders that are West Des Moines (or Cumming) residents to check out a family pass to six local venues: Blank Park Zoo, Des Moines Children's Museum, Greater Des Moines Botanical Garden, Reiman Gardens, the Science Center of lowa, and now Nelson Pioneer Farm & Museum. Patrons can reserve passes to each venue once every 365 days.
