

With this in mind, we are taking a break from using MOBIUS and all other ILL systems to give us time to find a process and products that better meet the needs of our patrons and staff. Effective Friday, July 12, we discontinued ILL service due to ongoing issues with placing, receiving, and tracking these requests. Outstanding requests will be processed. We will update you on our progress by August 8 or before.

This is a temporary measure—we are working hard behind the scenes to find a great solution that will be effective and easy to use. During this transition period, we ask our patrons to have patience and grace with us.
