Due to losing our reservation software vendor, the lowa Libraries Adventure Pass will be put on pause starting December 31st. The calendar is still open for new reservations thru December 31.

Reservations that were previously made for dates past December 31st will still be honored. However, new reservations are not being taken for dates after December 31. Be sure you have Printed Out any already-booked pass, as access to the booking system will be blocked for both patrons and library staff by December 31.
