### Q: Request items from other libraries? (Interlibrary Loan)





A: MOBIUS and Prospector are Interlibrary Loan request options, for borrowing books from other libraries that we do not own. They are integrated into our Encore catalog and are easy to use!

Search for an item by typing in the Search box. If we don't have it, you can search for the item in MOBIUS. Click on the MOBIUS link in the top right of the screen. This will perform the same search you just entered, but in the MOBIUS catalog.

Once you find the title and format you want, click the Request It button – a pop-up opens. Choose MOBIUS - West Des Moines Public Library from the drop-down menu then click Submit. Finally, fill in Your Name and Barcode (your WDM Library card number), then click Submit above information.

f asked to select a specific copy or location, choose any one that states it is Available. When you have chosen your item, click on Request Selected Item and this will tell the lending library to send it to the WDM Library.

Once the item comes in via courier – usually within two (2) weeks – the items will go on the Holds shelf and you will get notified in the usual way through email, phone call or text depending on your existing preferences. A due date will be noted on the item.
