# Raising Our Unattended Minor Age from Eight to 10 Years Old

At the April 19 meeting of the West Des Moines Public Library Board of Trustees, the Board voted to raise the age at which children may be alone at the library from eight years of age to 10 years of age. The Board also decided that those acting as caregivers for younger patrons must be 14 years or older.

Library staff will only intervene with unattended children if problems of safety, disruptive behavior, or well-being arise.

"The safety and well-being of patrons is a top priority for the West Des Moines Public Library Board of Trustees, Administration and staff," says Darryl Eschete, library director. "These changes were made to ensure safe and pleasant library visits for everyone."


#### **Family Storytime**
