## Q: Get help from the library while filing my taxes?



A: We are happy to help you find the documents that you need to print in order to file your taxes. Please call ahead to the Adult Services Desk (515-222-3403) to make sure we have what you need. You can always use our Internet stations print from the IRS and State of Iowa tax sites (printing/copying = 20 cents/page).

Federal Taxes: The WDM Library does NOT carry loose forms or booklets. The Library makes some masters of major forms, instructions and tables, which can be photocopied at 20 cents/page. You can also find them<u>online</u>.

State Taxes: The State no longer provides a master form book to Libraries for copying. We will make a few masters of major forms for you to photocopy (20 cents/page) once the forms are published (usually by mid-February) – anything else can be found on the State of Iowa tax site.

In addition to these Sensory Spaces times, patrons of the West Des Moines Public Library are always welcome to ask for noise-cancelling headphones (Adult Services Desk) and various fidget devices (any service desk) to make each visit to the library as enjoyable as possible. On the first floor we also have a Health Room with dimmable lights. Visit the Children's Desk to access the key for this room.
