## Q: Check out a set of books for my book club?

A: We have sets of titles, mostly fiction, previously read in one of our four book clubs (Adult Club Read, YA Not Club Read, Kids Club Read and Kids Graphic Novel Club Read). Requests must be placed at least 24 hours before your desired pick-up time. We process book club requests Mon-Fri – if you would like to pick up on a weekend, please ensure that your request is placed prior to Friday. Each set of books is due back 8 weeks from the time they are shipped from or leave our library.
